The applicant must be a member of DECA during the current school year. The applicant may select any accredited institution or university offering careers in a related field. The Scholarships are based on merit, not financial need. However, if an applicant chooses, he or she may include a statement in support of financial need and it will be reviewed.

Applicants must have a 3.0 grade point average or higher to apply for this scholarship.

Deadline for application: February 12, 2019.

Hand written applications will NOT be reviewed by the scholarship selection committee. Applications are on-line and should be completed, then printed and submitted.

The following items **MUST** be included with the application:

- ◆ The application form completed in its entirety.
- ◆ Headshot photo of applicant.
- ◆ An official transcript of grades.
- ◆ Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) or American College Testing Program (ACT) score.
- ◆ Two (2) letters of recommendation. One letter may be from your chapter advisor, however this is not a requirement.
